Parents need to contact the school to explore this option. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Mask/Facial Covering Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff are required to wear face coverings unless they meet one of the state approved exemptions. Unless exempt, it is required that students in grades K-12 wear masks or facial covering when outside of their classroom and where social distancing of six feet is not possible.
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Operating Scenarios	
COVID-19 Condition Green	- All students attend a normal schedule five days a week.
COVID-19 Condition Yellow	- Individual student or staff quarantine. Quarantined students and/or staff join their classroom remotely.
COVID-19 Condition Orange	- Specific class/building closure due to outbreak. Online remote learning in closed class/building only.
COVID-19 Condition Red	- Belmont County reaches Public Emergency Level 4 (Purple) or recommended complete closure by Belmont County Health Dept. Complete online remote instruction.

Our plan is to open the school year on the Green Level. However, due to possible changes/directives from the Governor and the Belmont County Health Department, we may need to change this decision.

Anytime we go out of the green level we will utilize new technology at the school that enables students to join their classroom face-to-face remotely. Teachers will also have the capability to teach their face-to-face classroom from home.

In an effort to maximize social distancing and minimize Covid19 exposure, grade levels have been reassigned to the following buildings: Elementary Bldg PreK-3rd grade, Middle School Bldg 4th-6th grade, and High School Bldg (IFLC) 7th-12 grade.
