Hot Lunches

Beginning on October 5, we will begin offering hot lunches to K-12 students on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for two weeks. DeFelice Pizza will still be the provider on Mondays and Fridays; Riesbecks will be available on Wednesdays. Beginning October 19, we will offer hot lunches all five days per week. Mondays and Fridays will be DeFelice and Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays will be Riesbecks. Please remember that all hot lunches/drinks are paid through your Prepay lunch account in FACTS. The system allows you to preload money ("Add Funds") onto your child's lunch account; when your child receives his/her food in the lunchroom, our staff will process those charges through the cash register and into your FACTS account. Should you need assistance *Adding Funds*, or if you have any questions, please feel free to call the Finance Department.

Dress Down Charges

Just a reminder that dress down charges are processed through FACTS. Once the Finance Department receives the information from all homeroom teachers, the charges are processed to FACTS under Incidental Billing. Unfortunately, due to the varying parameters on payment plans and incidental bills, your dress down charges will not always coincide with tuition due dates.
