FACTS Account Reminders

<u>Payment Plans</u> - Each family (or financially responsible parent/guardian) should have a payment plan, even in situations of scholarships and financial aid. *If you haven't yet set up a FACTS payment plan for the 23-24 school year, please do so ASAP.* The FACTS account allows you to not only pay for tuition, but also other incidental expenses, such as field trips and athletic fees, associated with the school year.

Lunch Prepay Accounts - In the Finance portion of your FACTS Family Portal, you will see this Prepay section for lunches. By clicking Add Funds, you can deposit money into the prepay account to cover upcoming student lunch charges. We recommend checking your balance often so that charges do not get over \$25.

<u>One Call Phone System</u> - East Richland Christian Schools will use the One Call System to notify families in the case of an emergency. This system is also used to quickly communicate important information to all our school families. If you have not received the One Call messages or know that we do not have your current phone number, please contact the school to ensure the correct contact information is on file.
